RETURNING STUDENT APPLICANTS

Former DePaul students originally enrolled into an undergraduate degree program must complete a returning student application if any of these conditions exist:

1. Absence from DePaul for three or more consecutive quarters, excluding summer sessions.
2. Academic dismissal from DePaul. A dismissed student can be considered for readmission after a period of two quarters, excluding summer sessions. Please note that dismissed students typically must complete outside course work before being readmitted. A dismissed student must apply in order to receive advising on course selections. Upon readmission contact your college office.

All returning student applications are required to meet the deadlines listed in this application.

TRANSCRIPTS OF TRANSFER WORK

Applicants who have attended another academic institution since last enrolled at DePaul must have official transcripts sent directly from each institution to the address below. Official transcripts must be received by the deadline dates, and for students who have completed transfer work, official transcripts will form part of the application for readmission.

RETURNING STUDENT GUIDELINES

Students will be readmitted into the college in which they were previously enrolled. Generally, students in good academic standing at the time they withdrew from the university should be allowed to return to DePaul. Returning students are bound by the standards of the university catalog in effect at the time of readmission. Students who wish to enter a new college must have been in good academic standing when they last attended DePaul, earned 12 quarter hours in residence as a degree-seeking student and a minimum 2.0 GPA at DePaul.

Students wishing to enroll in Music or Theatre also must meet interview and/or audition requirements. Students wishing to transfer to the College of Education must have at least a cumulative 2.5 GPA at DePaul.

IMMUNIZATION

Illinois state law (Illinois Administrative Code Section 694.100) requires Illinois colleges and universities to request proof of immunizations for all students (undergraduate, graduate and professional) registered at least part time. The Office of Student Records is responsible for collecting and reporting this information. Upon readmission, complete the immunization form available on the Office of Student Records website at sr.depaul.edu/immunizations.

ACADEMIC ADVISING

Academic advising is required of all returning degree-seeking students before registering for classes. After being readmitted, please contact your college to make arrangements for academic advising.
