Accelerated Degree Completion Majors (DCM)-

Bachelor of Arts in Leadership Studies or Bachelor of Arts in Applied Behavioral Studies

A student who has already earned an AA or AS degree can complete the BA in Leadership Studies or the BA in Applied Behavioral Sciences in 2 years. These degrees offer a schedule of courses that covers 93 of the required 192 quarter hours. Classes meet both on campus Tuesday evenings and online.
