Post-Baccalaureate College of Education Graduate Teacher-Preparation Certificate Programs Treated as Fifth-year Undergraduate Programs for Purposes of Federal Financial Aid Loan Limits and Dependency Status

College of Education financial aid-eligible post-baccalaureate graduate teacher-certificate programs are treated as fifth-year undergraduate programs for purposes of federal financial aid loan limits and dependency status. To qualify for financial aid consideration, you must be accepted to a financial aid-eligible post-baccalaureate non-degree teacher preparation graduate program and be in good academic standing; you must complete a [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#); and you must meet all federal financial aid eligibility requirements.

Available financial aid for non-degree financial aid-eligible post-baccalaureate graduate teacher certification programs:

- Federal Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loans at the 5th Year undergraduate level, as follows:
 - Dependent Students: \$5500; undergraduate lifetime limits apply
 - Independent Students or those whose parents cannot obtain the Parent PLUS Loan: \$12,500; undergraduate lifetime limits apply
- Federal Parent PLUS Loan, for dependent students
- All other types of institutional, state, federal or private loans for which you qualify
