Curriculum Updates

In June 2016, CDM updated the name of the BS in Information Assurance and Security Engineering to the BS in Cybersecurity. This change was made to acknowledge the now widely accepted term “cybersecurity” and its prominence in our degree programs.

The BS and BA in Digital Cinema were reconfigured into two new degrees a generalist BA in Film and Television degree and a BFA in Film and Television that allows for specialization in one of nine concentrations.

The BS in Computer Game Development was split into two separate degrees: a BS in Game Programming and a BS in Game Design.

Women at CDM

CDM continues to support the efforts of our student organization for women, HerCDM. The group provides our female students with opportunities for networking, service, and leadership development. Females make up 28% of the undergraduate CDM student population.

Facilities

CDM regularly expands and updates computing, production, and classroom space. Most recently we’ve added another soundstage to the 20,000 square foot production facility we already house at Cinespace Chicago Film Studios.
